

<u>Corpus Christi – 2 June 2024</u> <u>Thought for the Week</u>

I think the most important thing we can do on the Feast of Corpus Christi is not to explain some aspect of the Eucharist but to be in awe and wonder and marvel at this great mystery and presence. This feast was born in Belgium in the early 13th century. Pope Urban IV extended it to the whole Church in 1264. Why was it necessary to institute a new feast? Doesn't the Church recall the institution of the Eucharist on Holy Thursday? Doesn't she celebrate it every Sunday and weekday? Corpus Christi was the first feast whose object was not to celebrate an event in the life of Christ, but a truth of faith - that Christ is truly present in the Eucharist. Body, soul and divinity, Christ is truly present in the consecrated bread and wine.

Pope Francis often speaks at the importance of 'Wasting time adoring' Christ present in the Holy Eucharist. He says, 'It is good to adore in silence before the most Blessed Sacrament, to be in the consoling presence of Jesus, and to draw the apostolic impetus to be instruments of goodness, tenderness and welcome in the community the Church, and the world'.

Every Friday from 10:00 until 16:00 we have Adoration of the most Blessed Sacrament in St Edward's Church. I'm pleased so many are committed to come and spend time here before Our Lord. But I must admit, I do wonder why more do not come. Why not consider calling into the Church and spending a little time. Time spent this way will enable us to do all the things that we are called to do – and to do them with greater love.
