

Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time – 7 July 2024 Thought for the Week

The gym I go to has music playing 24 hours a day! Every shopping centre and sometimes restaurants and bars are continually playing background music. What ever happened to silence? I was very proud of our First and Middle schools last week when Bishop Philip made a visit. The Bishop led a Liturgy in both schools which contained a considerable amount of silence - and the children were more than able to enter into this stillness and prayer.

I sometimes reflect on Sundays how we can be sometimes 200 or 300 people in the church and not feel uncomfortable in being in silence - where else in society would you feel comfortable in silence with people who perhaps you do not know well?

Pope John Paul II said: "In communal, shared stillness and silence, we accept in our hearts the full resonance of the voice of the Holy Spirit and unite our prayer more closely to the Word of God and the public voice of the Church"

During liturgical silence, under the action of the Holy Spirit, all respond in their own way recollecting themselves, pondering what has been heard, taking the Word of God to heart, preparing a response to it in prayer, petitioning and praising God in the spirit.

Silent reflection and contemplation is an essential dynamic of our celebration of the Mass. Words and music are important – but so is silence.

Our FHC team are now accepting registrations for the 2024-25 First Holy Communion programme. Further details plus application forms can be found on the Parish website. A meeting for parents will be held on 26 September at 18:30. For those families wishing to enrol their children (who are in year 3 or above) we shall be having a threefold programme, as follows:

Step 1: 'Come and See' (John1: 39-41)

For 6 weekends from the 28/29 September to 2/3 November. The candidate is required to attend weekend Masses with family members. At the beginning of November, a Commitment Ceremony will be held.

Step 2: 'They sat at the feet of Jesus' (Luke 10:38-42)

The Saturday morning sessions, at 10:00, start at the beginning of November where the candidates will prepare with their parents for First Reconciliation and Holy Communion.

Step 3: 'Jesus Sent them Out' (Luke 10:1)

The Holy Communion Mass will be followed by an invitation to do something for the community and will be introduced to the Mini Vinnies in the parish (Junior SVP).

To enrol in step 1 please fill in an application form that can be found on our website. The introduction and the unfolding of the programme will be on **Thursday 26 September at 18:30 in St Edward's Parish Centre**. At this meeting of parents, you will receive the 'Commitment Card' that needs to be stamped when your child attends Mass. Further dates will be given at this meeting.

Please note the closing date for applications is Monday 16 September 2024.
