Thought for the Week

I feel a little sorry for the prophet Amos in this Sunday's reading, He really didn't want to be a prophet and seemed to be rather lonely all by himself. This is rather contrasted by today's Gospel when Jesus insisted that the disciples should go out in twos to proclaim the Good News. There's something about doing things with other people to give us encouragement and hope. I really believe that our two parish communities of Ascot and Windsor will gain great strength and encouragement by working together and becoming one united Parish. We are stronger together - and our two communities, like the disciples in pairs, can gain confidence in going out and bringing other people to Jesus Christ.

Symbolically this weekend our two newsletters have become one. Yes, it is different and I'm sure they will be teething problems as we get it just right for our communities - bear with us and let us celebrate and share all the good practice that both our communities presently have in different areas.

The mission given to the disciples is given to us. I'm pleased that we have within both of our communities a small group of people who in September will organise a way that each week we can pray for those living on a couple of roads in our parish. The week before, an attractive card will be delivered to homes in that road, informing them that we will be praying for them at the weekend and a candle will burn for them in the Lady Chapels. The card delivered will also say that if they would like to have their house blessed or have a visit then to contact us. The New Lectionary Books

The cost of the Ambo edition (the books the readers read from at Masses) is £695 for all 4 volumes and the cost of the Book of the Gospels (which the priest proclaims the Gospel from at Sunday Masses) is £275.
