## Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time - 21 July 2024

## **Thought for the Week**

In our First Reading this Sunday, Jeremiah reflects firstly on God's scattered flock and then tells us that the Lord "will raise a virtuous Branch for David." Who is this virtuous branch? Jesus: he, as Son of God, gathers the remnant of the flock and brings them back to their own pasture, he is the Good Shepherd. Why does he do this? Out of love for us, his sheep.

At the beginning of today's Gospel passage we see small snapshots of Jesus' great love: firstly, for the apostles when he wants them to rest following their mission of preaching and healing that they have just returned from; and then, when stepping ashore and finding a large crowd, being moved with pity for the people because they were like sheep without a shepherd.

This love would find its fulfilment on the Cross on Calvary as Jesus gives himself for each one of us — a saving love that he continues to pour out on each one of us and that we celebrate at every Mass. As the sheep of his flock, we are called to respond and follow him wherever he guides us. Let us pray especially for Stephen Patterson who, in response to the Lord's call in his life, will be ordained Deacon by Bishop Philip in Portsmouth this Saturday. Let us reflect on how the Lord is calling each one of us today and as his people together here in Ascot and Windsor. May the Lord strengthen us in our calling and give us all the grace to respond ever more fully to his great love for us.
